



SCAMBLER TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING MINUTES-APPROVED

TUESDAY, MAY 18, 2021, 7:10 PM

Present: David Ritchie, Dennis Carlblom, Todd Langseth, Erick Johnson, Nance Hebert, Sandy Tingelstad, and Christie Shulstad.

The Board Meeting was called to order at 7:06 pm by Chairman David Ritchie with the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Board Meeting was held under CDC and MN Covid 19 guidelines for vaccinated and unvaccinated individuals. Guidelines were updated May 14, 2021.

Approval of the Agenda: 3.2% Liquor License approval for Walleye World was moved to 1a on the agenda. Erick Johnson made a motion to approve the agenda as amended. Todd Langseth seconded the motion. Motion approved.

1a. – 3.2% Liquor License Approval: David Ritchie made a motion to approve the 3.2% Liquor License for Walleye World. The motion was seconded by Erick Johnson. Motion approved. The liquor license was signed by Chairman David Ritchie and Clerk, Sandy Tingelstad.

Clerk's Report Minutes: Minutes from the March 25, 2021 from Scambler Township Reorganization meeting, April 6, 2021 Local Board of Equalization and Appeal meeting, and April 8, 2021 Board Meeting was presented. Motion by Todd Langseth to approve the minutes. The motion was seconded by David Ritchie. Motion approved.

Treasurer's Report: Treasurer Christie Shulstad presented the financial report for April, 2021 and May claims for approval. Erick Johnson made a motion to approve the treasurer's report and claims. The motion was seconded by Nancy Hebert. Motion approved. The checks for claims were signed.

Communications: Three communications were received and read. Two were thank you letters from West Central Initiative and Pelican Rapids Library for contributions from the township. The third was advertising from Tri-State Paving.

Zoning Report: No report.

Road Report: Road Supervisor Dennis Carlblom reported Egge Const. has received road maps for areas where gravel shall be dispersed. Dennis has been in contact with Corbin Excavating re: dustguarding. It has been too dry to grade roads so hoping for rain soon so grading and dustguarding can be completed. Graveling and dustguarding will begin on South Sand Lake Road and 460th. Will continue on 205 and 490th.

Discussion was held on the need for *NO PARKING* signs on South Pelican Drive by the Pelican Lake public access. There has been overflow parking from the lake access onto both sides of the township road, especially on busy weekends. Difficult for through traffic with parking on both sides of the township road. Dennis Carlblom made a motion to install *NO PARKING* signs on South Pelican Drive from the apron on County Hwy 9 up to the top of the hill on both sides of the township road. Dave Ritchie seconded the motion. Motion approved.



Property Board Report: Property supervisor Erick Johnson reported the septic tank needed pumping again after the alarm sounded. Majority of the pumping was water. Erick will investigate whether there is ground water seeping into the tank or another cause.

A number of fluorescent bulbs are burned out and need to be replaced in the townhall. Dennis Carlblom made a motion to replace the fluorescent bulbs with LED bulbs. David Ritchie seconded the motion. Motion approved. Todd Langseth will do the exchange.

New Business: Discussion on the Planning and Zoning Committee. No board action taken.
