



SCAMBLER TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING MINUTES-APPROVED

THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 12, 2020, 7:00 PM

Present: Dave Ritchie, Mike Johnson, Todd Langseth, Dennis Carlbom, Dave Pederson, and Sandy Tingelstad.

The Board Meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Chairman Dave Ritchie with the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Board Meeting was held under MN executive order of 6 ft social distancing between occupants, mask requirement, and no more than 10 people in the townhall.

Approval of the Agenda: Dennis Carlbom made addition 1a to the agenda. Dennis Carlbom made a motion to approve the agenda as amended. Todd Langseth seconded the motion. Motion approved.

1a: Jess and Melissa Schoon, residents on Tamarac Lake, Linda's Beach Road, approached the town board re: vacation of a road. Residents are in the process of selling their property and have discovered irregularities in the legal description of their property, which include a portion of Linda's Beach Road. After discussion, the town board recommended the Schoons retain an attorney to correct the legal description of their property before any action can be taken by the Town Board.

Clerk's Report Minutes: Minutes from the October 8, 2020 from Scambler Town Board meeting was presented. Motion by Dennis Carlbom to approve the minutes. The motion was seconded by Mike Johnson. Motion approved.

Treasurer's Report: Dave Pederson submitted the Treasurer's report and claims. Dennis Carlbom made a motion to approve the Treasurer's report and claims. Mike Johnson seconded the motion. Motion approved.

Road Report: Mike Johnson reported the township roads are in good condition.

Corn along 490th St needs to be cut down before winter weather arrives for snow plowing concerns. Arntson Construction will remove the corn.

There are deep ruts on the road shoulder along 460th St that require repair before winter weather. Arntson Construction will repair the shoulder before winter.

A culvert on Cha Rosa Beach road is almost plugged. With winter coming, the culvert will have to be unplugged in the spring of 2021.

Other reports: Sandy gave a brief report on the November 3, 2020 election. Scambler Township had steady voters all day and reported an 89% voter turnout, including absentee ballots and in person voting.
